#### **Information That We Collect**

Martin Yarborough and Associates LLC processes your personal information to meet our legal, statutory and contractual obligations and to provide you with our products and services. We will never collect any unnecessary personal data from you and do not process your information in any way, other than as specified in this notice.

#### **How We Use Your Personal Data (***Legal Basis for Processing***)**

Martin Yarborough and Associates LLC takes your privacy very seriously and will never disclose, share or sell your data without your consent; unless required to do so by law. We only retain your data for as long as is necessary and for the purpose(s) specified in this notice. Where you have consented to us providing you with promotional offers and marketing, you are free to withdraw this consent at any time. The purposes and reasons for processing your personal data are detailed below: -

#### Marketing, Business, Communication

#### **Sharing and Disclosing Your Personal Information**

We do not share or disclose any of your personal information without your consent, other than for the purposes specified in this notice or where there is a legal requirement. Martin Yarborough and Associates LLC occasionally uses third-parties to provide the below services and business functions; however, all processors acting on our behalf only process your data in accordance with instructions from us and comply fully with this privacy notice, the data protection laws and any other appropriate confidentiality and security measures.

#### **Safeguarding Measures**

Martin Yarborough and Associates LLC takes your privacy seriously and takes every reasonable measure and precaution to protect and secure your personal data. We work hard to protect you and your information from unauthorised access, alteration, disclosure or destruction and have several layers of security measures in place, *including:* -

#### **How Long We Keep Your Data**

Martin Yarborough and Associates LLC only ever retains personal information for as long as is necessary and we have strict review and retention policies in place to meet these obligations. We are

required under US law to keep your basic personal data (name, address, contact details) for a minimum of 6 years after which time it will be destroyed.
